Waste materials must be characterized to determine its proper disposal place. Materials found to be “hazardous” must be properly labeled and stored in the chemical shed to the north of Thompson Bldg. and disposed of through a licensed transporter.

Facilities personnel should be aware of these requirements for all construction materials used onsite. Solid or Liquid waste materials that you are uncertain of their hazardous status can be analyzed by reviewing the Materials Safety Data Sheet [MSDS] or by laboratory analysis. Steps to take if you are unsure of the waste material:

1. Complete the label shown above and include an MSDS (if available).
2. Identify where product was used, or if found, where it was found.
3. Contact Dave Ramsey to ensure material is placed **INSIDE** the chemical storage shed.

Please do **NOT** leave any waste container unlabeled or unattended at any time.
